Individual Student Supplies: You need these things..... 😊

- Clear View, 1/2" to 3/4" three-ring binder.
- Zipper-pouch for pencils OR plastic pencil box (9x3x6), no locks
- 4 two-pocket folders.
- A steady supply of pencils-- (Ticonderoga, please)
- Pink pearl or white bar erasers
- Hand-held pencil sharpener with shavings container--not electric
- Fine-tipped Crayola markers (I will provide the wide-tipped kind)
- 24-pack of colored pencils-- Crayola
- Inexpensive headphones or earbuds (which you may already have at home)
- 1 single subject spiral notebook with lined paper (college or wide ruled)
- Personal water bottle, labeled with your name
- 2 packs loose leaf, lined notebook paper. One pack at home and one to school
- Glue sticks—Several at home, 3-5 at school
- 2 thin Expo markers for working on personal whiteboards
- 1 pack of graph paper to school for later

Optional Student Items: Rulers, scissors, gel pens, felt tip/Flair pens, black Sharpies, Bic (or better) mechanical pencils + lead refills, and personal whiteboards are optional. I'll provide yellow highlighters but you may bring other colors.

Please DO not bring: Mini stapler/staples "desk pets", toy erasers, tape, stickers for your desk, Apple watches, candy, or gum,
